# ABOUT US

## FOUNDATION PILLARS

These guiding principles tie into the Foundation's own pillars that uphold our values. These three pillars exemplify our commitment and objectives.

#### PILLAR 1

AGAT Laboratories founding principles in its operations rely heavily on the lessons the Canadian Geese adopt in flight and these same values have been imparted on the AGAT Foundation in its use of the Geese logo. In line with the lessons of our Canadian Geese, we have learned directly that when people work together, with a common direction and values, we can reach our goals.

## **★** 1ST LESSON:

People who share a common direction and a sense of community are traveling on the thrust of one another. Whenever a goose falls out of formation, it suddenly feels the drag and resistance of trying to go it alone and quickly gets into formation to take advantage of the lifting power of the bird immediately in front.

## **■◆■** 2ND LESSON:

If we have as much sense as geese, we will stay in formation with those who are headed where we want to go. When the lead goose gets tired, he rotates back in the wing and another goose flies point

## ■ 3RD LESSON:

It pays to take turns doing hard tasks and share leadership inter-dependent with each other. The geese honk from behind to encourage those up front to keep up their speed. (What do we say when we honk from behind?)

### **4TH LESSON:**

We need to make sure our honking from behind is encouraging, not something less helpful. Finally, when a goose gets sick or wounded by gun shots and falls out, two geese will fall out of formation and follow him down to help and protect him. They stay with him until he is either able to fly or until he is dead and they launch on their own with another formation to catch up with the group.

# **■** 5TH LESSON:

If we have as much sense as the geese, we will stand by each other like that.


# ALBERTA CANCER FOUNDATION PATIENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM


